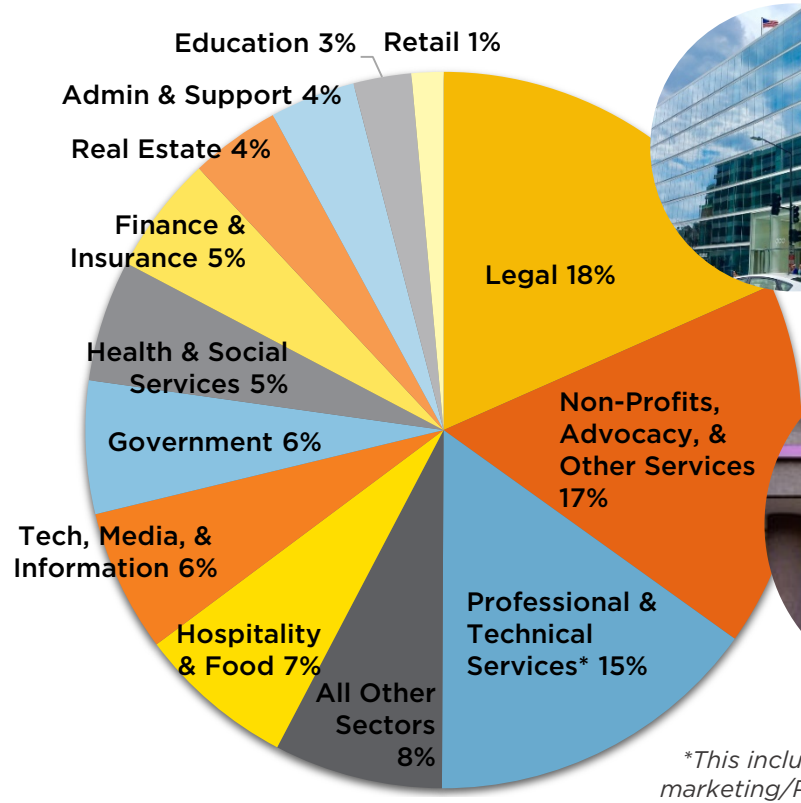


# Job Sectors in the Golden Triangle versus Citywide

Percent of All Jobs in the Golden Triangle by Sector, 2019



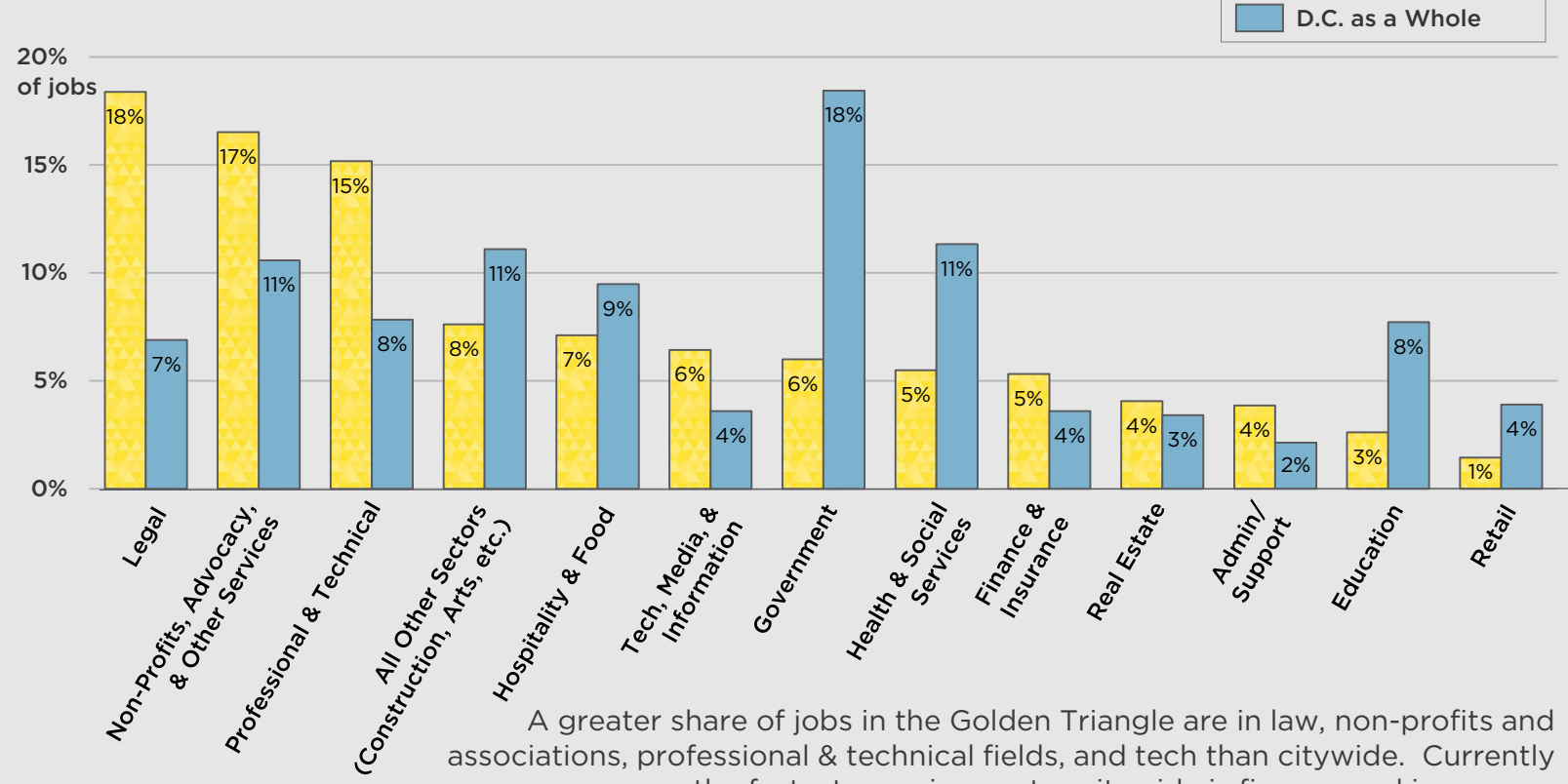
The Golden Triangle has more than 700 law firms and law-related businesses. About 15,300 of all workers in the BID are in this sector. Large firms anchor many of the BID's newer buildings, like Cassidy Levy Kent at 900 19<sup>th</sup> St NW (at left).



Nearly 1,000 advocacy organizations, charities, unions, and other non-profits call the Golden Triangle home. Many are long-term tenants or own their buildings, while others are competing to lease affordable space in older Class A and B buildings.

\*This includes architecture & engineering, accounting, scientific research, marketing/PR, design, and other technical fields; it excludes legal services.

## Golden Triangle versus D.C. - Comparison by Sector



A greater share of jobs in the Golden Triangle are in law, non-profits and associations, professional & technical fields, and tech than citywide. Currently the fastest-growing sector citywide is finance and insurance.
