
## Tech in the Golden Triangle: Celebrating InnoMAYtion!



Co-working spots like WeWork, Carr Workplaces, & MakeOffices help fuel the growth of startups and small businesses in the BID. Alley, a member-based space at 2055 L St, runs tech networking events and serves as an incubator. 15% of all jobs in the Golden Triangle are in the innovation sector, defined as those in STEM fields. Among those, computer systems-based occupations (e.g. software design) account for 3% of all jobs in the BID.
