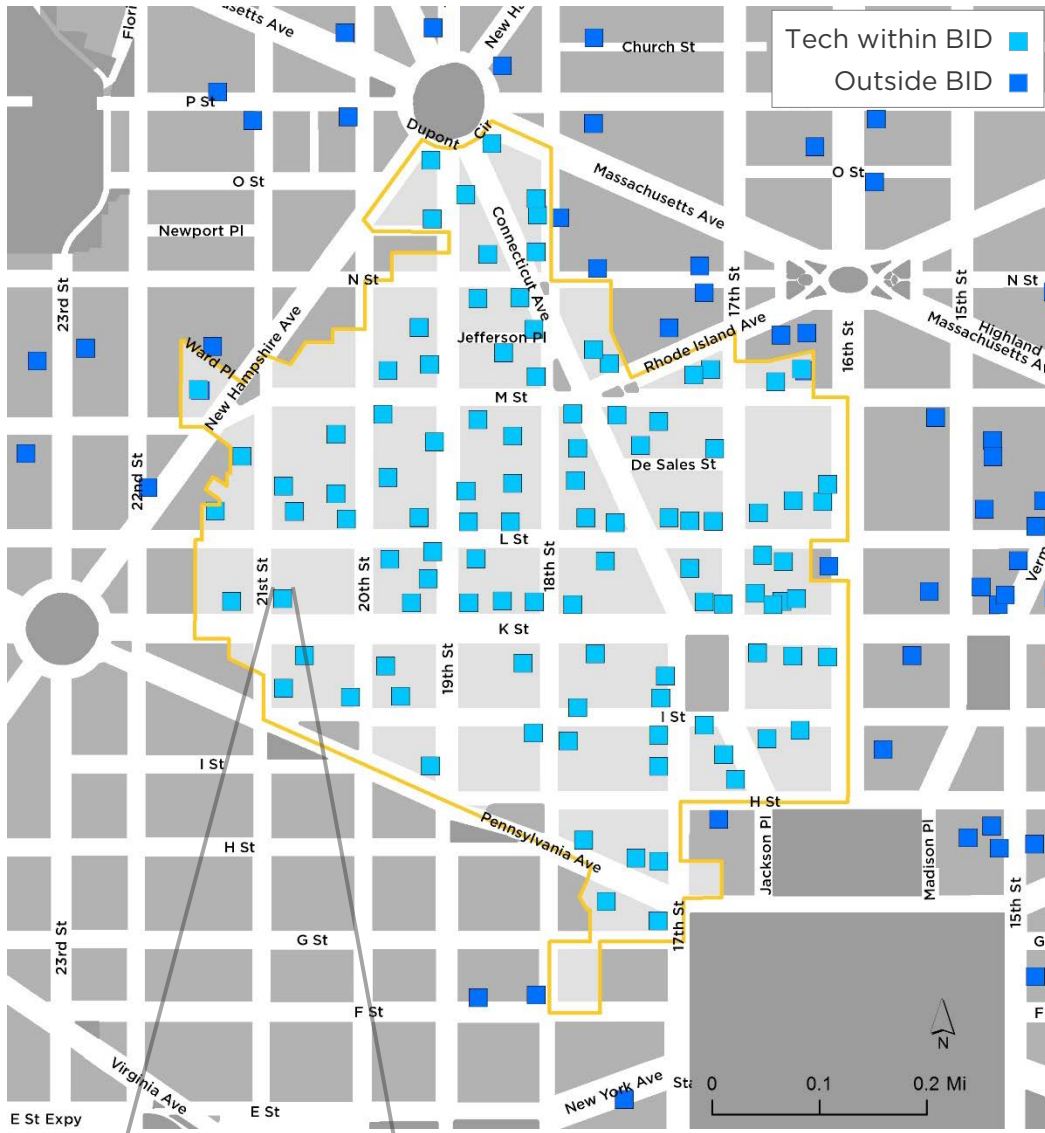


Tech in the Golden Triangle: Celebrating InnoMAYtion!

The number of innovation firms has **grown 25%** since 2014, employing over **11,500 people** in the BID



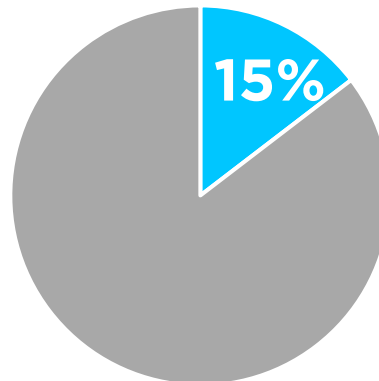
D.C. startups **are growing fastest** within the fields of **e-learning**, fundraising, aviation, **health & wellness**, **financial services**, HR, and **IT** services.

15% of all jobs in the Golden Triangle are in the innovation sector, defined as those in STEM fields. Among those, computer systems-based occupations (e.g. software design) account for 3% of all jobs in the BID.
